






fig. 2. Pina Bausch





fig. 3. Reading Lolita in Tehran: A Memoir in Books by Azar Nafisi










fig. 2. William Forsyth





fig. 3. The Waves by Virginia Woolf






fig. 3. The Cairo Trilogy by Naguib Mahfouz




fig. 3. Momo by Michael Ende






fig. 2. Guerrilla Gir







fig. 3. White Teeth by Zadie Smith


fig. 2. Boriss Bērzinš




fig. 4. List of films








fig. 2. Edward Hopper




fig. 3. A Time to Kill by John Grisham








fig. 2. Věra Nováková







fig. 3. The Master and Margarita by Mikhail Bulgakov












